

Registered Occupational Therapists working with CTGHG

Work individually and as part of a team with clients and families of all ages whose lives have been affected by physical illness or injury, developmental delays, mental illness, the aging process and/or psychosocial problems. You provide assessment, intervention and advice with regards to life skills required for independent living to clients their families and the inter-professional team. You will have the autonomy to manage your own caseload to meet the needs of your clients, as well as, giving you the flexibility to schedule your own day.

As a member of our inter-professional team you will recommend individualized home or school based treatment . This may include teaching your clients, families, school staff or others on the inter-professional team an activity program or about safe transfers. You will be assessing your clients for ADL and wheelchair/seating equipment. You will be completing pre-discharge assessments to determine a client's needs before they leave the hospital. You may be required to complete cognitive assessments and suggest strategies to assist with safe functioning of the client in their home, school or community environment. You will be suggesting energy conservation and pain reducing strategies for clients experiencing fatigue or pain.

You may have the support of a Rehabilitation Assistant to follow through on your program suggestions and assist with fabrication of devices.
